June 12, 2026, depart from Windsor/ Essex County in the afternoon by motorcoach to Toronto airport where we catch our flight to Dublin. This is an overnight flight with Air Canada leaving at 8:40pm.

June 13, 2026, This morning we will arrive in Dublin at 8:15 am, make our way through the airport and head to our first Irish experience. A Welcome lunch in an Irish Pub! We will experience the warm atmosphere of Mickey Finns in Co Wicklow. This award winning Gastro Pub has all dishes paired to local craft beers brewed next door across the courtyard in the Wicklow Brewery. Included in Lonely Planet's top 20 best pubs in Ireland. Afterward, we journey south along the scenic coastline to Wexford, a charming town rich in maritime history and culture. Take time to settle in and enjoy the tranquil surroundings of our hotel, set on the banks of the River Slaney. (L, D - Ferrycarrig Hotel, Wexford)



June 14, 2026, Step back in time this morning as we visit New Ross to board a replica of the Dunbrody Famine Ship. This immersive experience highlights the harrowing journeys of Irish emigrants during the Great Famine, offering a poignant start to the day. From there, we'll head westward, making a stop at the Marine Bar for a lively music session and the chance to enjoy some traditional Irish tunes. The day concludes as we arrive in Cork, Ireland's "Rebel City," where you can explore its bustling streets and soak in the vibrant atmosphere. (B, D - The Metropole Hotel in Cork)

June 15, 2026, This morning we bid farewell to Cork and travel east to the historic Blarney Castle, where those feeling adventurous can kiss the famous Blarney Stone to gain the “gift of the gab.”(Optional) (B, D, - Ballygarry Hotel , Tralee)



June 16, 2026, We take the short drive to the heritage town of Kenmare this morning. We then travel the Ring of Kerry road back into Killarney thru' Moll's Gap where we visit a traditional working sheep farm. In the evening, enjoy a traditional Irish dinner and entertainment at Quill's Farmhouse, a lively experience filled with music and storytelling. (B, D - Ballygarry Hotel, Tralee)



June 17, 2026, We start the day in Tralee, then we board the Shannon Ferry across the estuary. From there, we head to Doolin for an unforgettable cruise along the base of the Cliffs of Moher. The towering cliffs, rising 700 feet above the Atlantic Ocean, are a sight to behold from the water. Capture the breathtaking views and immerse yourself in the majesty of this natural wonder before settling into our hotel for the evening. (B, D - Armada Hotel)



June 18, 2026, Today's journey takes us through the Burren, a unique limestone landscape known for its wildflowers and ancient archaeological sites. As we traverse the midlands, we make a stop at Kilbeggan Distillery, the oldest licensed distillery in Ireland. Here, we'll enjoy a guided tour that delves into the history and craftsmanship of Irish whiskey, followed by a tasting of their signature spirits. Then settle into our hotel before free time tonight to explore Dublin. (B - The Gresham Riu Plaza)



June 19, 2026, Spend the day discovering the best of Dublin with your Hop On/Hop Off pass, which gives you the freedom to explore at your own pace. Visit iconic landmarks such as Trinity College, home to the Book of Kells, or stroll through the lush greenery of St. Stephen's Green. Take in the lively shopping districts or enjoy a pint at a traditional pub. The evening is free to explore the vibrant streets, dine in world-class restaurants, or simply soak up the lively atmosphere of the capital city. Dinner this evening will be at Taylors Three Rock! Three Rock Mountain, one of the most prominent peaks on the South County Dublin skyline, rises directly behind the pub and provides a gateway to the infamous Dublin and Wicklow mountains. After Dinner you have the evening to yourself (B, D - The Gresham Riu Plaza)



June 20, 2026, This morning we will check out of the hotel and say goodbye to Ireland! Boarding our Air Canada flight in the early morning at 9:50am, arriving in Toronto at 11:55 am to finish our journey home with new friends and fond memories!
